

The principle objectives are:

- to act as spokesman for the industry in relations with national and international institutions, policy makers, media and the public.
- to set up a forum in order to exchange views between IBMA members and to discuss issues of common interest. As a result of this exchange of views, position papers are published and brought to the attention of parties concerned.
- to set up and implement ethical professional rules.
- to ensure product quality standards required by the market.
- to contribute to a broader and more intensive use of biological crop protection, animal health and public hygiene.
- to offer training and information in order to improve skills of member company staff at their request, and consequently to improve their business performance.
- to offer the opportunity of conducting joint projects satisfying the needs of IBMA members.
- to ensure transfer of information between all interested parties.



Organisation

- IBMA is administrated by the Board and the Executive Committee that receives its power by delegation
 of the General Assembly of members
- The General Assembly elects a president, a vice president and a treasurer that together with the Executive Director form the IBMA Board
- The Executive Committee is composed of the members of the Board, the Professional Group chairs and two National Group representatives
