

### Bernard Blum - the founding father of IBMA

1938 - 2014



- An independent jury selects a winning procontrol product to receive the Gold award. It must demonstrate an effective solution in the management of pests or diseases while having a low impact on human health and the environment —. Silver and Bronze recognition are also awarded to second and third placed innovations
- For the first time this year a fourth award is also being made for best innovative product assisting the uptake of biocontrol
- Since the first awards in 2015 there have been typically 12 to 15 entries every year
- IBMA will award a trophy to the winner
- They will be interviewed and will have product placement in New Ag International and 2BMonthly publications, as well as complementary registration for ABIM in the following year
- All four winners are given the chance to present their innovations. The shortlisted finalists also have a poster to display their innovations in the ABIM booth.

## The Panel of Judges

- Alberto Urbaneja
  - Valencian Institute of Agricultural Research (IVIA), Spain
- Johannes Jehle
  - Julius Kühn-Institut, Darmstadt, Germany
- Owen Jones (Coordinator, Judge and Chair), UK
- In the case of a tie David Cary has a casting vote









#### What we look for?

- Each entry is scored independently by each judge against four criteria:
- Scientific Foundation and Merit
- Degree of Innovation
- Contribution to **Sustainable Agriculture**
- Commercial opportunity
  - Has to be for biocontrol
  - Has to be registrable if required
  - Has to be novel
  - Has to have the potential to make an impact in the market

## Scoring

- Each judge evaluates every entry against the four criteria:
- Scientific, Innovation, Sustainable Agriculture and Commercial
- Adding the scores for each criteria gives a total score for that entry.
- The entries are then ranked first to last by each judge
- Owen Jones then combines all the rankings to give an overall rank first to last
- All entries are eventually listed on the IBMA website
- The products Assisting Biocontrol Uptake are also assessed using the same criteria
- The winner and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place are announced at ABIM together with the winner of the Assisting Biocontrol Uptake category
