Definitions

- Low-risk Substances
- Introduced by R(EC) 1107/2009
- LR-based PPP are of low risk: no spec. RMM
- Criteria (Annex II)
- End of the routine evaluation



Definitions


- Low-risk Substances
- Introduced by R(EC) 1107/2009
- LR-based DDD are of low rick; no Low-Risk:

 spec. R
- Criteria
- ➤ First approval for 15y
- ➤ Fast-track PPP authorisations (120d)



Overview of LR substances

- New process
- 7 substances approved as LR
 - 5 new ones
 - 2 renewed AS





Updating the LR criteria

- Criteria relevant for chemicals
- Update clause in R(EC)1107/2009
- Dedicated WG: draft proposal
 - Different sets of criteria
 - Specific criteria for different origins
- Internal consultation on-going

- Former 4th batch of EAS:
 - approved in 1 go in 2009
 - several strains of biopesticides or semiochemichals
- 214 AS (118 in 2019)





Reshuffling AIR4

- 4 batches
 - Renewal process launched
 - Potential low-risk substances (+1y)
 - Potential failing substances (+1y)
 - Other substances (+2-3y)
- Need to prolong current approvals

- Fruitful pre-submission meetings
- Exhaustive dossier
- Specific issues
 - Secondary metabolites
 - Genotoxicity
 - Antibiotic resistance

Preparing AIR4 dossiers

- Addressing the new data requirements
- Exhaustive literature search
- Using all the available guidance or information
 - EU guidance (as noted), working documents
 - OECD guidance, reports (BPSG seminar)
 - Proceedings (NL Workshop 2015, EPPO 2016...)






Biopesticides - where now?







Low-risk and AIR program

- □ AIR-1 7 substances 14 MS -
- □ *AIR-2* 31 substances 21 MS 2 LR
- □ *AIR-3* 150 substances 28 MS **7? LR**
- □ *AIR-4* 214 substances 28 MS **63? LR**



Accelerating sustainable plant protection

- Expert group on Sustainable Plant Protection (19 MS, COM, EFSA)
- Implementation plan endorsed by agriculture ministers in Council (June 2016)
- 40 short term and long term actions identified to:
 - Increase availability of low-risk products
 - Accelerate implementation of IPM in MS
- Scope: 2016-2017 and beyond



Actions focused on measures to...

- Expedite approval and authorisation procedures (within limits of Regulation 1107/2009)
- Support businesses to apply for low-risk approval and authorisation
- Clarify regulatory requirements
- Cooperate and share experience between MS
- Provide input for REFIT of 1107/2009 to increase regulatory incentives for low-risk products.
